

Using CCTV to deter and enforce against fly-tipping – Forestry Commission

Erecting a barrier did not deter them and people wanting to dump abandoned vehicles had tried to ram the barrier, damaging it on a number of occasions. The installation of CCTV cameras has been an effective deterrent – since the camera was fitted there has been no further damage to the barrier.
